Adoption Information and Counseling

Adoption Reimbursement Program

An adoption reimbursement program, administered by Progyny, can help to offset the high cost associated with adopting a child. Eligible expenses for reimbursement may include, but are not limited to the following:

- Legal fees
- Court costs
- Application Fees
- Adoption agency fees, including foreign adoption fees
- Home studies
- Translation services
- Parent, child, and family adoption counseling

- Travel expenses for child or adoptive parents
- Immunizations, if not covered by insurance
- Medical assessment of the child
- Medical expenses for the birth of the child
- Temporary foster care expenses
- Expenses for adopting children related to either parent or domestic partner, such as stepchildren, nephews, nieces, cousins, brothers or sisters
