Important Questions	Answers	Why This Matters:
What is the overall deductible?	In-network: Individual \$600 /Family \$1,200 Out-of-Network: Individual \$1,200 /Family \$2,400.	Generally, you must pay all of the costs from providers up to the <u>deductible</u> amount before this <u>plan</u> begins to pay. If you have other family members on the plan, each family member must meet their own individual deductible until the total amount of the deductible expenses paid by all family members meets the overall family deductible.
Are there services covered before you meet your deductible?	Yes. Preventive care and office visits are covered before you meet your deductible.	This <u>plan</u> covers some items and services even if you haven't yet met the <u>deductible</u> amount. But a <u>copayment</u> or <u>coinsurance</u> may apply. For example, this <u>plan</u> covers certain <u>preventive</u> <u>services</u> without <u>cost-sharing</u> and before you meet your <u>deductible</u> . Are there other deductibles for specific services?	No.	You don't have to meet deductibles for specific services.
What is the <u>out-of-pocket</u> <u>limit</u> for this <u>plan</u> ?	In-network: Individual \$4,000 /Family \$8,000; Out-of-network: Individual \$8,000 /Family \$16,000	The <u>out-of-pocket limit</u> is the most you could pay in a year for covered services. If you have other family members in this <u>plan</u> , they have to meet their own out-of-pocket limits until the overall family out-of-pocket limit has been met.
What is not included in the out-of-pocket limit?	Premiums, balance-billed charges, penalties for failure to obtain preauthorization for services and health care this plan doesn't cover. Certain specialty pharmacy drugs are considered non-essential health benefits and fall outside the out-of-pocket limits. The cost of these drugs (though reimbursed by the manufacturer at no cost to you) will not be applied towards satisfying your out-of-pocket maximums.	Even though you pay these expenses, they don't count toward the out-of-pocket limit.

Will you pay less if you use a <u>network provider</u> ?	Yes. For in-network providers, see www.aetna.com/dsepublic/#/sony or call 1-888-385-1053.	This <u>plan</u> uses a provider <u>network</u> . You will pay less if you use a <u>provider</u> in the plan's <u>network</u> . You will pay the most if you use an <u>out-of-network provider</u> , and you might receive a bill from a <u>provider</u> for the difference between the provider's charge and what your <u>plan</u> pays (<u>balance billing</u>). Be aware, your <u>network provider</u> might use an <u>out-of-network provider</u> for some services (such as lab work). Check with your <u>provider</u> before you get services
Do you need a <u>referral</u> to see a <u>specialist</u> ?	No.	You can see the specialist you choose without a referral.
